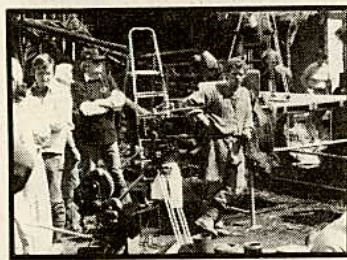


ON LOCATION WITH ROBIN OF SHERWOOD

We met up with him recently in the Bristol countryside, where the next series was being filmed. Though he wasn't working that day, Jason made a special trip to join us on the set to give *Look-in* readers an exclusive behind-the-scenes look at the fast and furious action. That's Jason waving hello in our picture below!

■ Little John (Clive Mantle) surveys the scene where some dangerous and dramatic action will shortly take place. Despite brilliant sunshine, powerful lights are rigged up so that no movement is missed.



■ Around 30 'crowd' extras have been brought in to play villagers in the exciting final scene to an episode: soon, they will be running for their lives! Beforehand, two of them enjoy a chat and a spot of knitting!

■ No such peace meanwhile for Will Scarlet (Ray Winstone) who's busy gritting his teeth and rehearsing a fight sequence. Note that the ground has been carefully treated with straw; it wouldn't do to have tyre tracks or boot prints in a scene from hundreds of years ago!

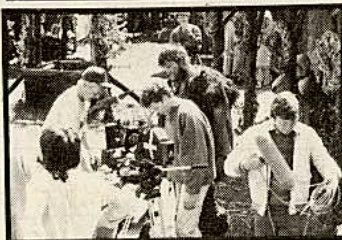
■ The actors have been sprayed with water to make it look like they're sweating. But, by this stage, the real thing is dripping from them!



■ Each episode takes two whole weeks to shoot, with only three to four minutes of usable action filmed a day. Much (Peter L. Williams) grabs a few moments' rest by one of the three cameras used.



■ Now to polish him off with a fearsome right hook! It all looks painfully realistic because of clever stunt work and split-second timing.



■ Up to 55 crew, including sound, lighting and camera staff, ensure the technical side of things runs smoothly. Little John, now in full costume and with his face carefully made up with dirt, looks on with interest.

■ A fireman hoses down a smoking village... the day's filming has been a success.
